#### *Abstract*

The present study is to assess the extent and nature of dis-

stress in family having a schizophrenic member and to evaluate the effect of psychosocial intervention programme on family distress of schizophrenia. This is conducted in an out patient and inpatient setting at institute of Human Behaviour and Allied Sciences, (IHBAS) Delhi. A sample of 60 patients including their family members constituted the study sample. Out of 60 samples, 30 cases were exposed to psychosocial intervention programme and rest 30 cases were as control group. The interview schedule is used for the purpose of data collection, consisted of five parts, namely, Socio-demographic clinical data sheet; semi structural interview schedule for assessing care giver's awareness about illness and attitude towards patient.
