Abstract

Examines the intra-industry (Horizontal) and inter-industry (vertical) technology spillovers effects of FDI across twelve Indian manufacturing industries. Estimation results provide evidence in favor of the long-run relationship between labor productivity of domestic firms and relevant regressors in the empirical model.
