Pablo Neruda Library Department of Germanic & Romance Studies Arts Faculty Building, University of Delhi, Delhi – 110007

Library of the Department of Germanic & Romance Studies named after Pablo Neruda was established along with the establishment of the Department (erstwhile Department of Modern European Languages) in the year 1948. On the occasion of the centennial of the birth of the renowned Chilean Poet-Laureate Pablo Neruda it was named after him on 4th February, 2004.

Presently the Departmental library has over 37,000 volumes largely on the specific subjects of foreign languages, culture and literary studies. It also has an important collection of books in English related to relevant area studies. The library indeed has an unique collection and could be of great use not only for the students and scholars of the Department of Germanic & Romance Studies but of other Departments as well.

Acquisition of books for the library is being partly done by the utilization of funds allocated in the annual budget and partly by mobilizing donations from educational institutions and through academic exchange programmes with France, Germany, Spain, Italy, Portugal and Romania. For Journal the library is completely dependent on irregular donations and exchange.

Library is situated in the Arts Faculty building adjacent to the Department. It occupies two halls/rooms and a gallery.

Consultation of the books and working in the Library is considered essential and integral part of the Studies carried out by the graduate and post graduate students. Therefore, library is being given an extraordinary importance. However the amount sanctioned in the annual budget for the purchase of books and the staffing pattern is highly inadequate. As per the requirements of the courses as well as the users demand the library needs to improve in following areas:

- a) Increase of budgetary allocation for the purchase of books (Upto 6 Lacs).
- b) Grant for Subscription of foreign journals (One lac)
- c) Semi-Professional-Assistant (One)
- d) Library Attendant (One)
- e) More space for separate reading hall and computer installations.

Department runs four Undergraduate and four postgraduate programmes in French, German, Spanish and Italian and two upto Advance Diploma level courses in Portuguese and Romanian. Therefore, books in foreign languages and of foreign publications are absolutely essential. The library is also being used by the Department students and outsiders, therefore it has rush and is always busy. The present strength of one SPA and one attendant is not able to give proper service. The Space for more than a thousand users is also needed.
