DELHI UNIVERSITY LIBRARY SYSTEM DOCTORAL THESES COLLECTION

The Central Library of the Delhi University Library System (DULS) stands as the esteemed depository of scholarly inquiry, entrusted with the guardianship and stewardship of doctoral theses approved by the University of Delhi for the conferment of the Doctor of Philosophy degree upon its researchers. Within its vast collection, it houses an impressive repository of 27,911 doctoral theses spanning 85 academic departments, each a testament to the spirit of intellectual pursuit fostered under the University's aegis.

Each year, DULS compiles and publishes a catalogue detailing the scholarly endeavours of the University, a volume that records and celebrates the doctoral theses produced within its halls. This publication, aptly titled *Doctoral Research*, is unveiled on the eve of the University's Annual Convocation.

A product of the new millennium, *Doctoral Research* came into existence in the year 2000. Yet, its lineage extends across half a century, tracing its origins to an earlier scholarly chronicle known as the *Handbook of Research Activities*. The roots of this endeavour reach back to 1957, when the Academic Council of the University resolved to inaugurate a publication under the title *Abstracts of Theses*. However, it took seven years before the first volume of the *Abstracts of Theses* could be brought out on the eve of the Republic Day in January 1964 by the Registrar of the University. This seminal work contained abstracts of fifty theses, carefully prepared by their authors, selected from among the seventy doctoral works approved by the University up to the academic year 1956–57.

Two decades later, in January 1984, another landmark publication emerged—*Doctoral Theses 1972–82*, an exhaustive record of 1,825 theses, issued in honour of the University's Diamond Jubilee. Recognizing the enduring value of such an initiative, the idea of establishing an annual compendium took shape. In 1986, under the leadership of Vice-Chancellor Professor Moonis Raza, the University revived the vision of a regular scholarly chronicle, ensuring that, henceforth, a comprehensive catalogue of doctoral research would be published annually on the eve of the University's Convocation

under the title *Handbook of Research Activities*. The following volumes of the *Handbook* were published annually:

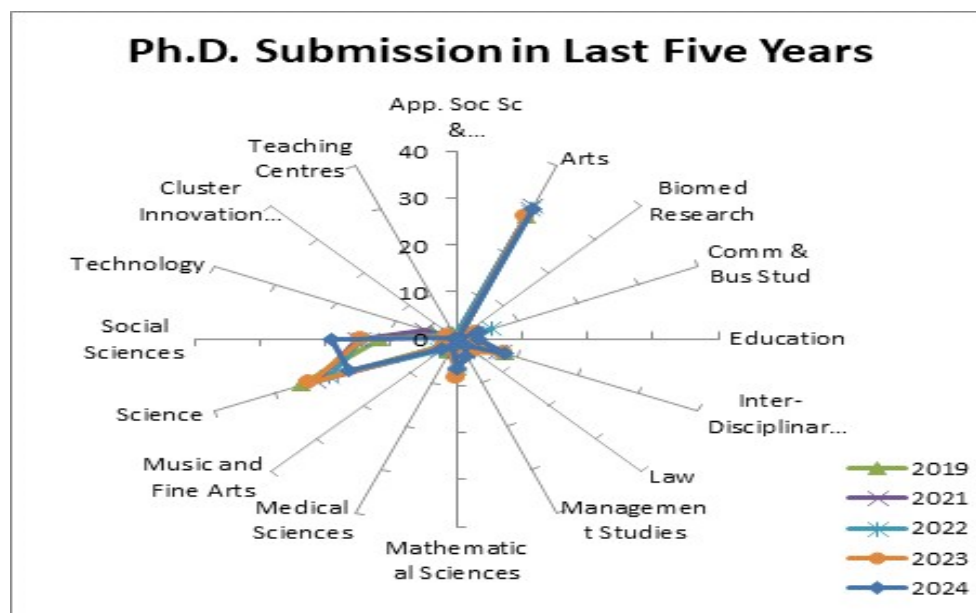

The University of Delhi, esteemed for its varied academic offerings, has continually generated research that substantially enhances world knowledge. Examining the research trends and themes in PhD theses published between 2019 and 2025 uncovers growing patterns that illustrate the evolving nature of academic inquiry and social demands.

In recent years, the fields at the University of Delhi have seen a significant transition towards interdisciplinary study, tackling modern global issues. There is a growing emphasis in the sciences on climate change, renewable energy technologies, biotechnology, artificial intelligence, and data science. Themes of social justice, gender studies, migration, and digital humanities have been prominent within the humanities and social sciences, mirroring the evolving political, economic, and social landscapes in India and worldwide. Subsequent thematic analysis of the theses indicates an increasing focus on the intersectionality of concerns. Current economic study frequently incorporates social inequity, worker rights, and environmental sustainability. In the social sciences, there is a marked rise in studies about the effects of digital transformation on education, healthcare, and public policy.

The expanding research landscape indicates that the University of Delhi aggressively addresses the demand for theoretically grounded information applicable to real-world challenges. The increasing focus on sustainability, technological advancement, and social inclusion underscores the institution's dedication to generating pertinent and influential research. Consequently, analyzing these topics provides significant insights into the prospective trajectories of academic research in India and its correspondence with worldwide trends.

The study presents two figures for the disciplines mentioned above, representing:

- a. **Word Cloud:** Highlights the prominent keywords extracted from the title of the theses, mainly showcasing the major trending topics in the respective discipline.
- b. **Thematic Evolution Map:** Shows the evolution of various research topics over the period of 2019-2025 and the relationship between these topics over time.



Figure 1: Word Cloud Based on Keywords extracted from the Title of the Theses

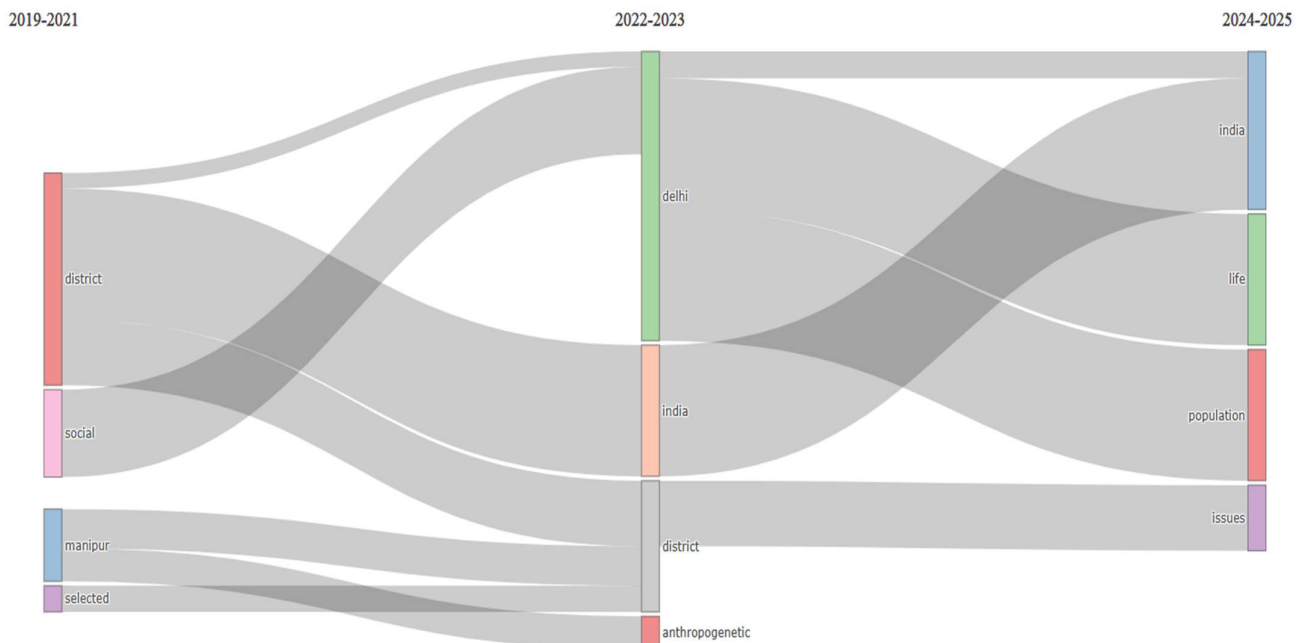


Figure 2: Thematic Evolution Map of PhD Topics from 2019 to 2025

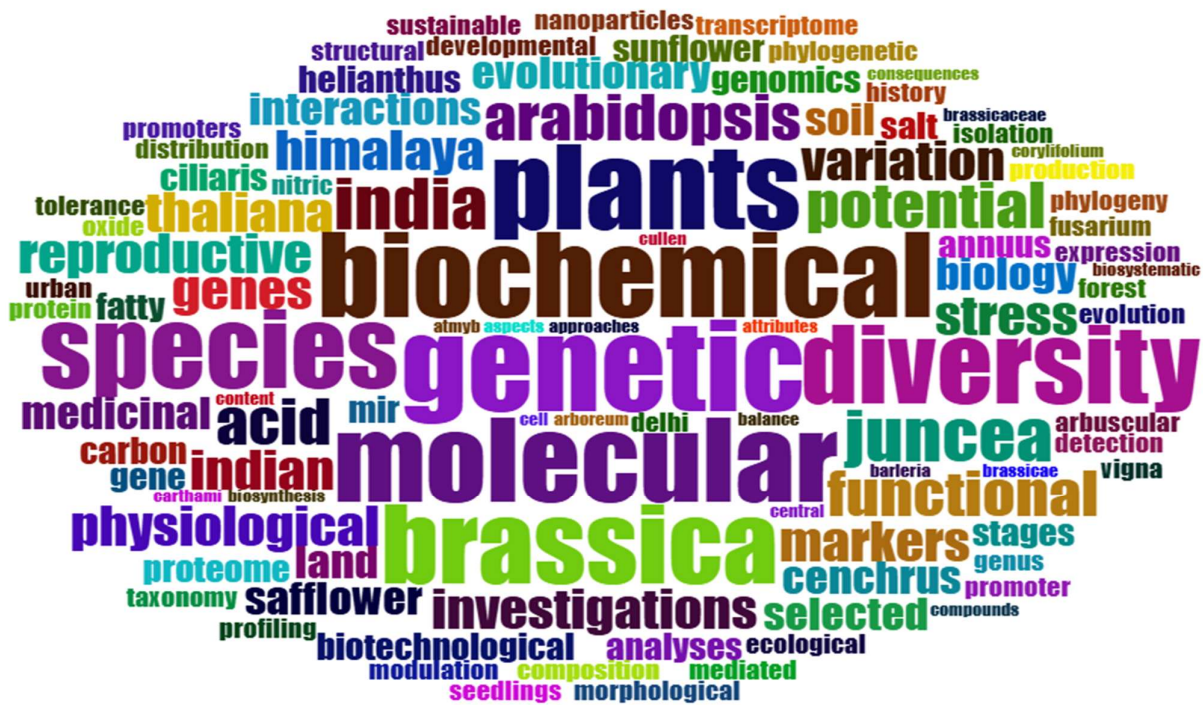


Figure 1: Word Cloud Based on Keywords extracted from the Title of the Theses

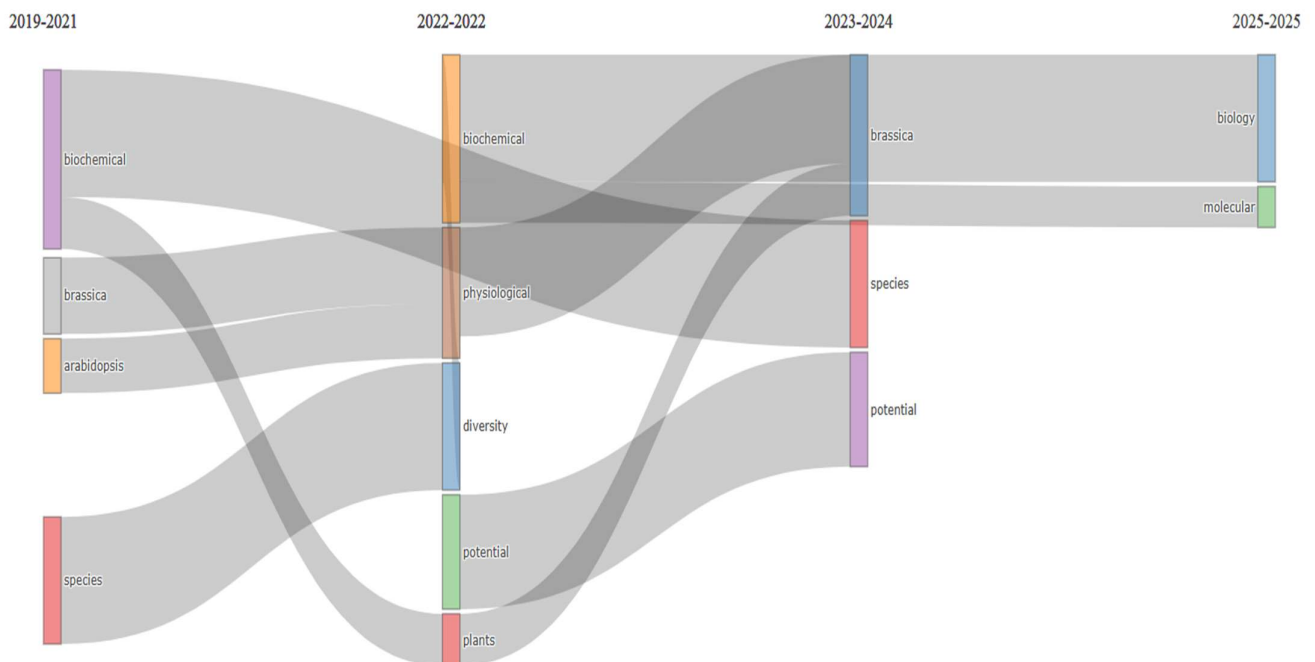


Figure 2: Thematic Evolution Map of PhD Topics from 2019 to 2025

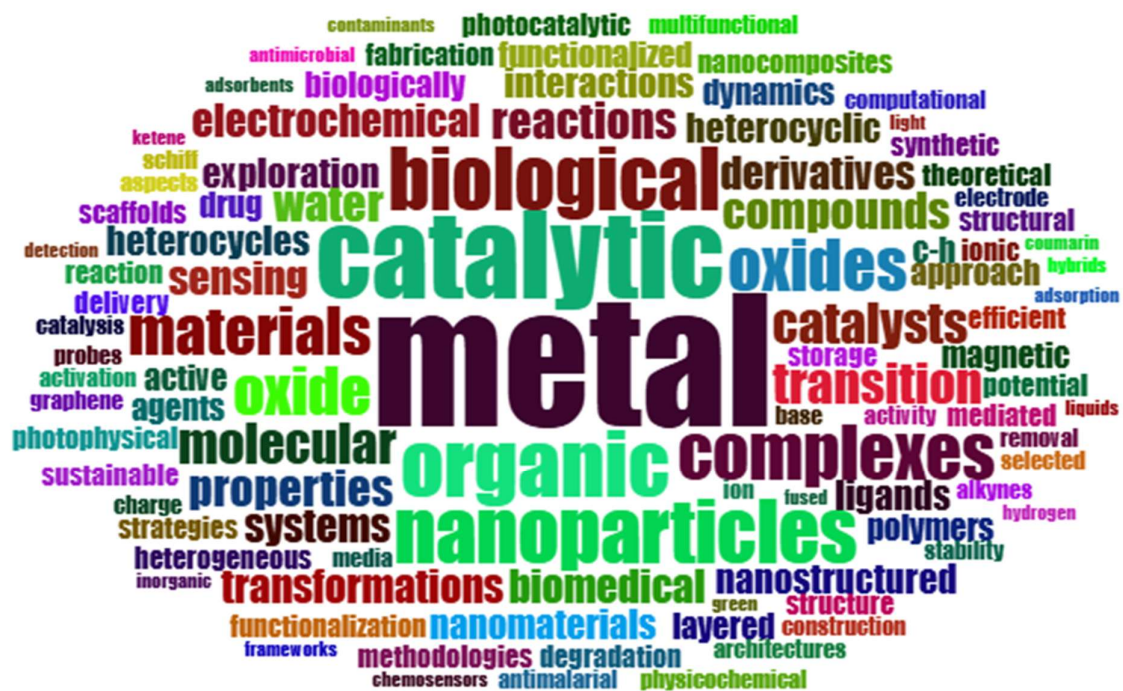


Figure 1: Word Cloud Based on Keywords extracted from the Title of the Theses

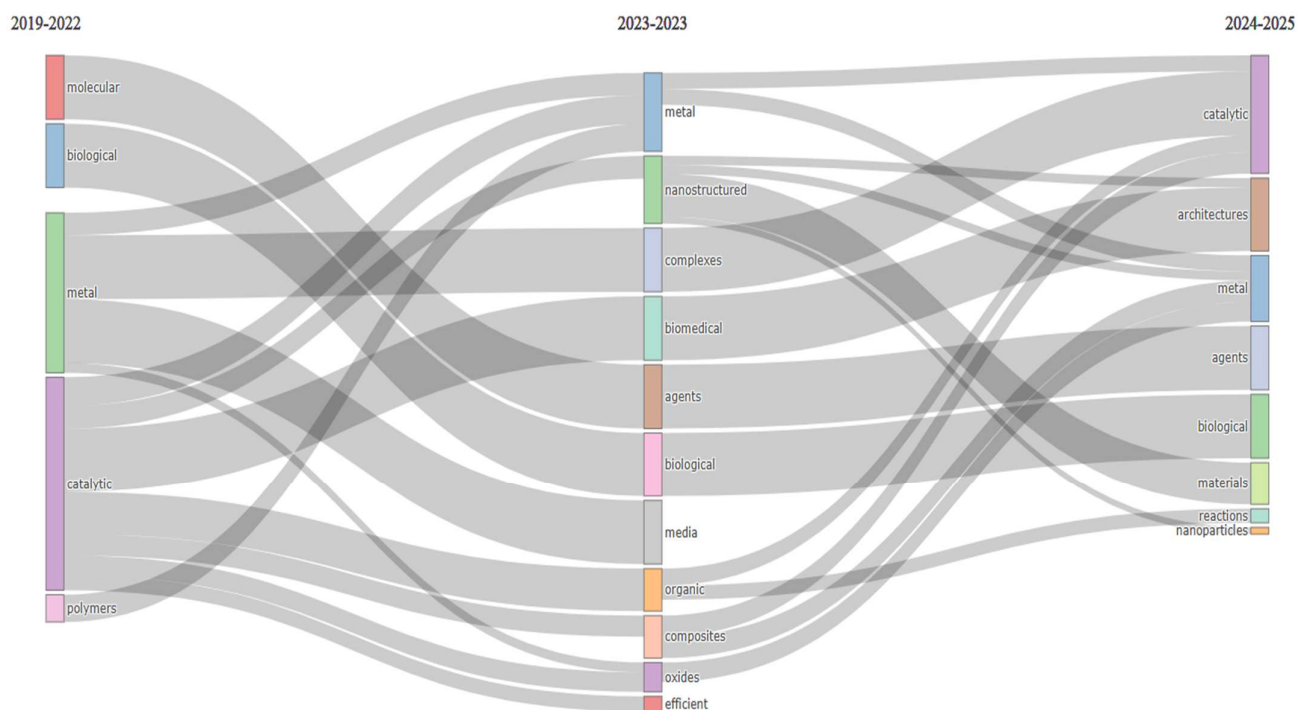


Figure 2: Thematic Evolution Map of PhD Topics from 2019 to 2025

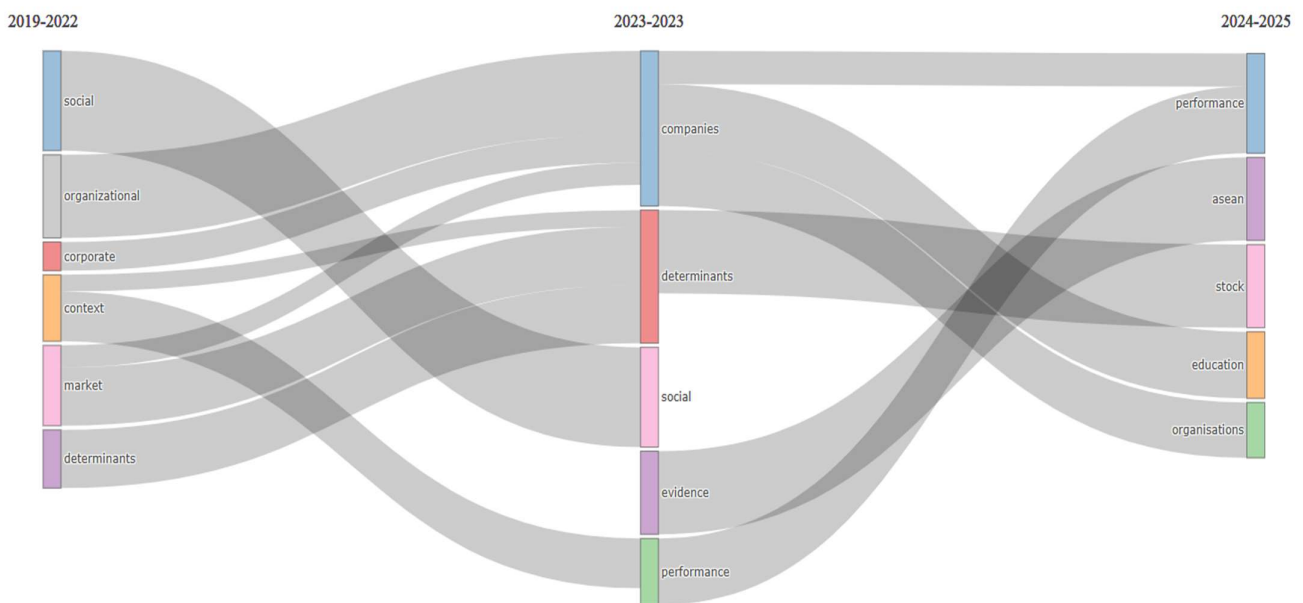


Figure 2: Thematic Evolution Map of PhD Topics from 2019 to 2025

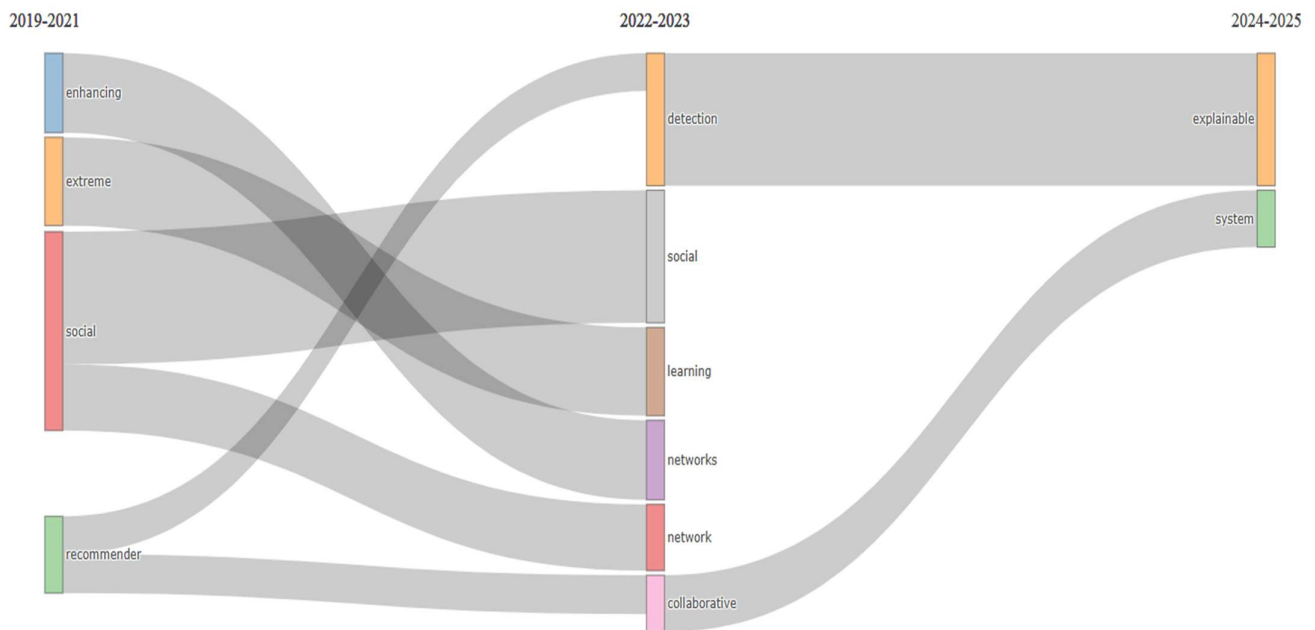


Figure 2: Thematic Evolution Map of PhD Topics from 2019 to 2025

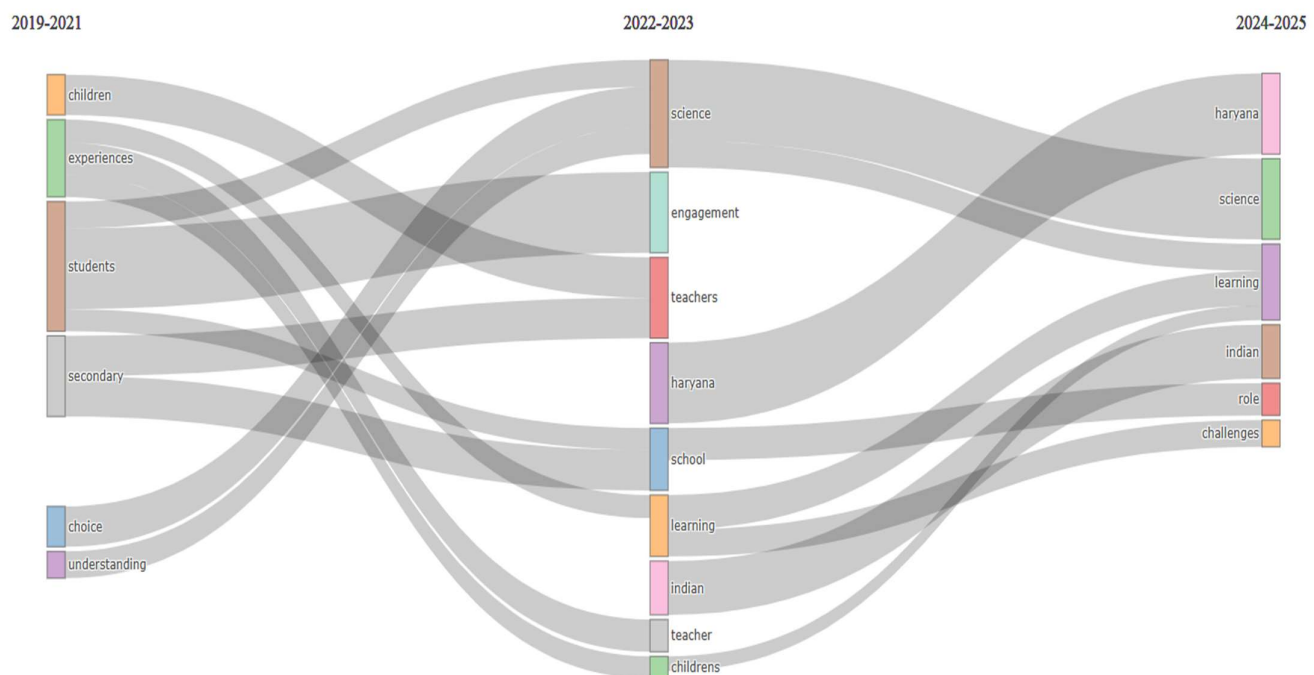


Figure 2: Thematic Evolution Map of PhD Topics from 2019 to 2025

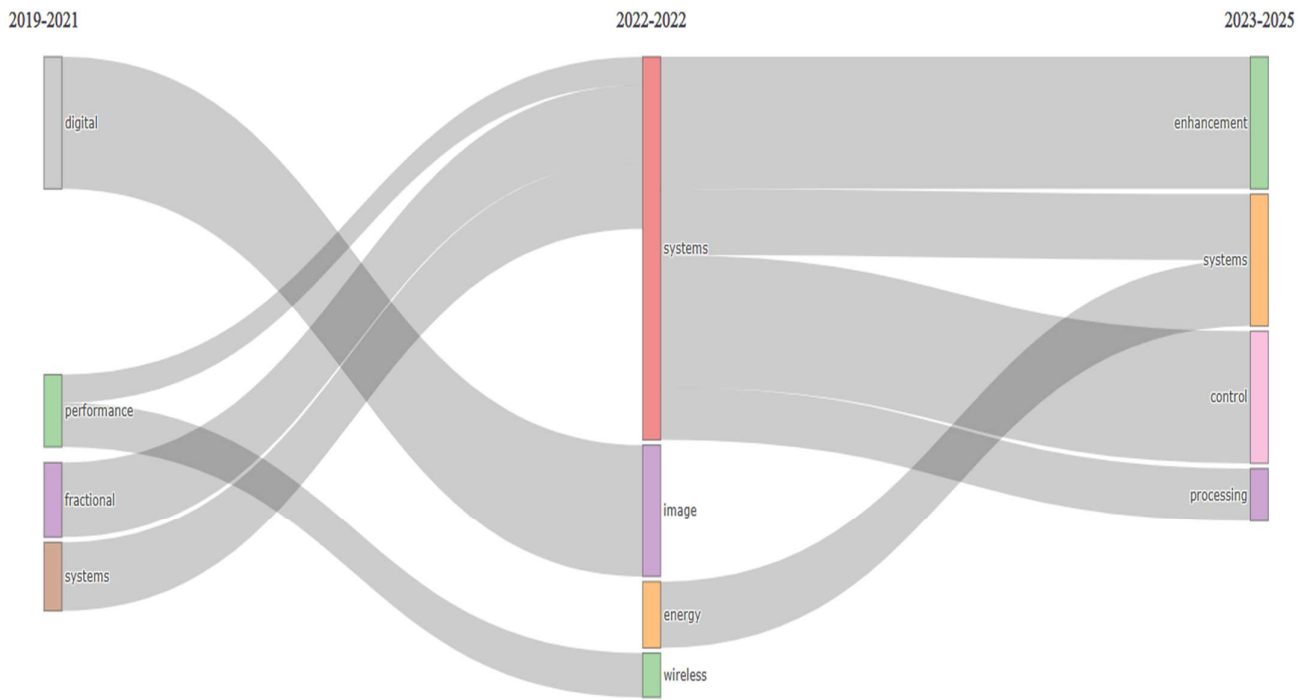


Figure 2: Thematic Evolution Map of PhD Topics from 2019 to 2025

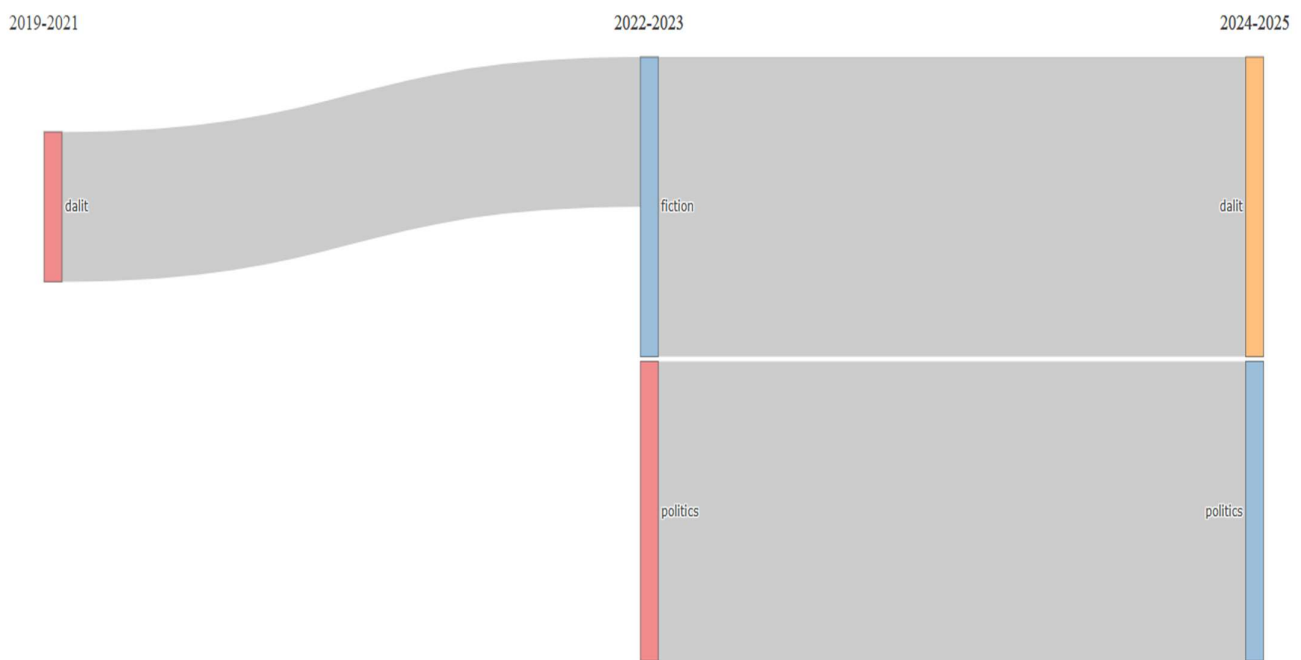


Figure 2: Thematic Evolution Map of PhD Topics from 2019 to 2025

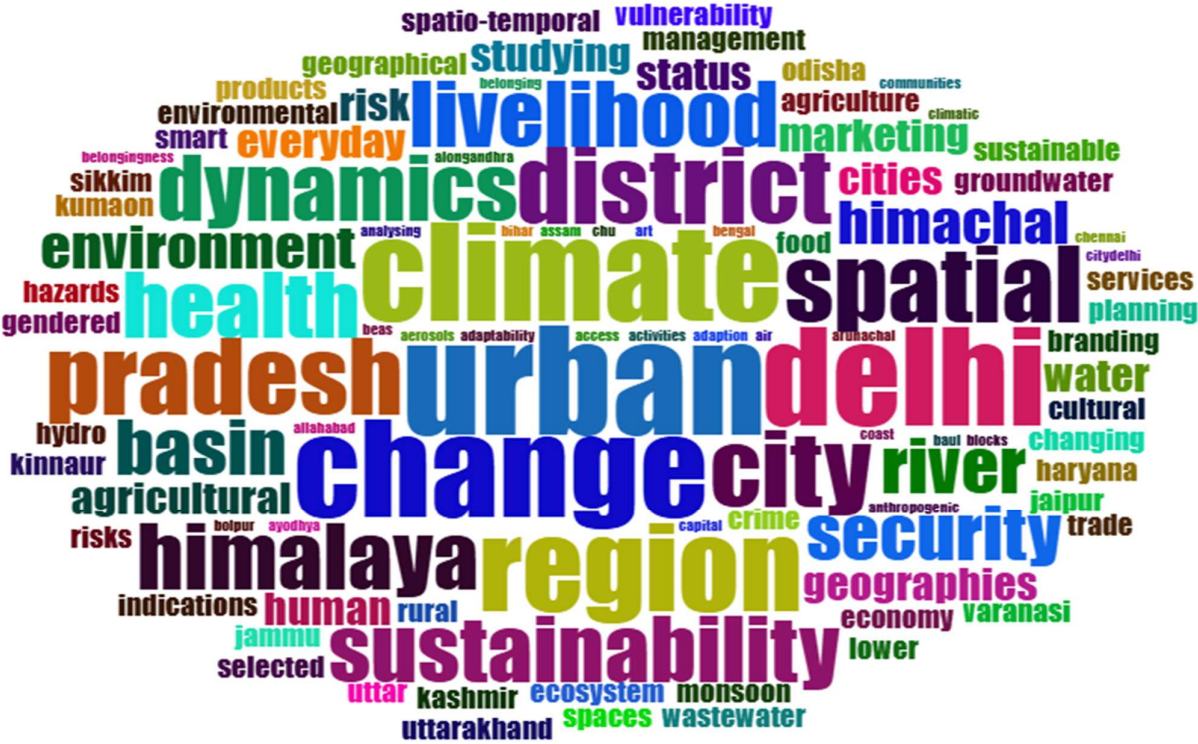


Figure 1: Word Cloud Based on Keywords extracted from the Title of the Theses

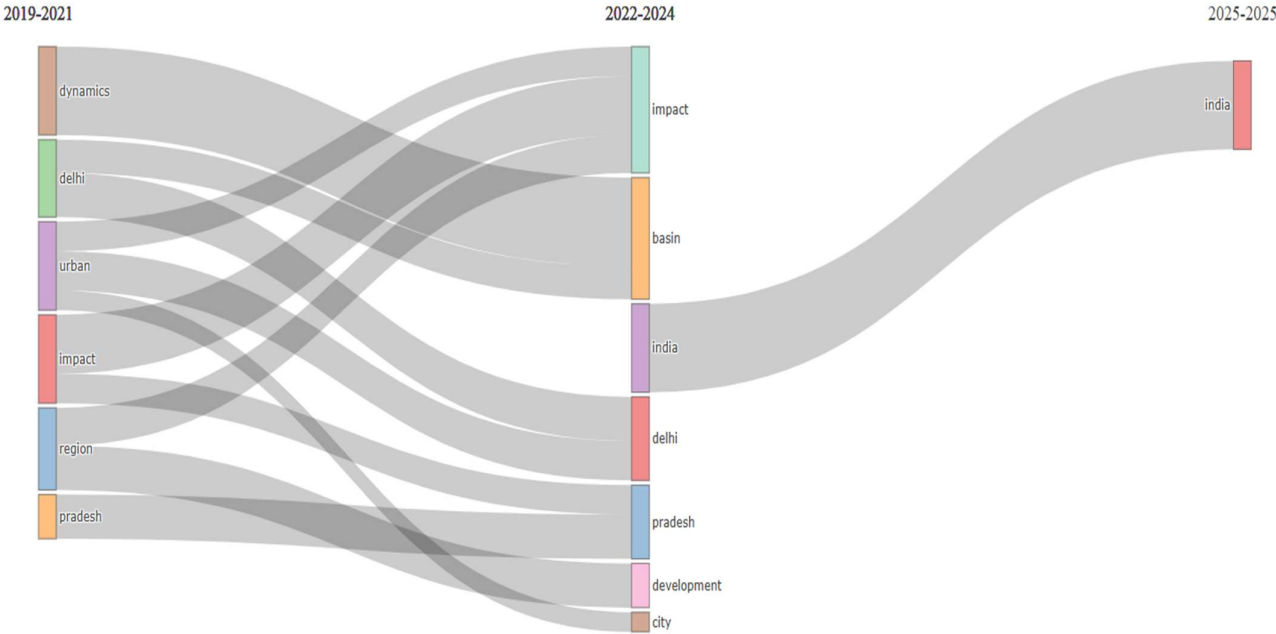


Figure 2: Thematic Evolution Map of PhD Topics from 2019 to 2025

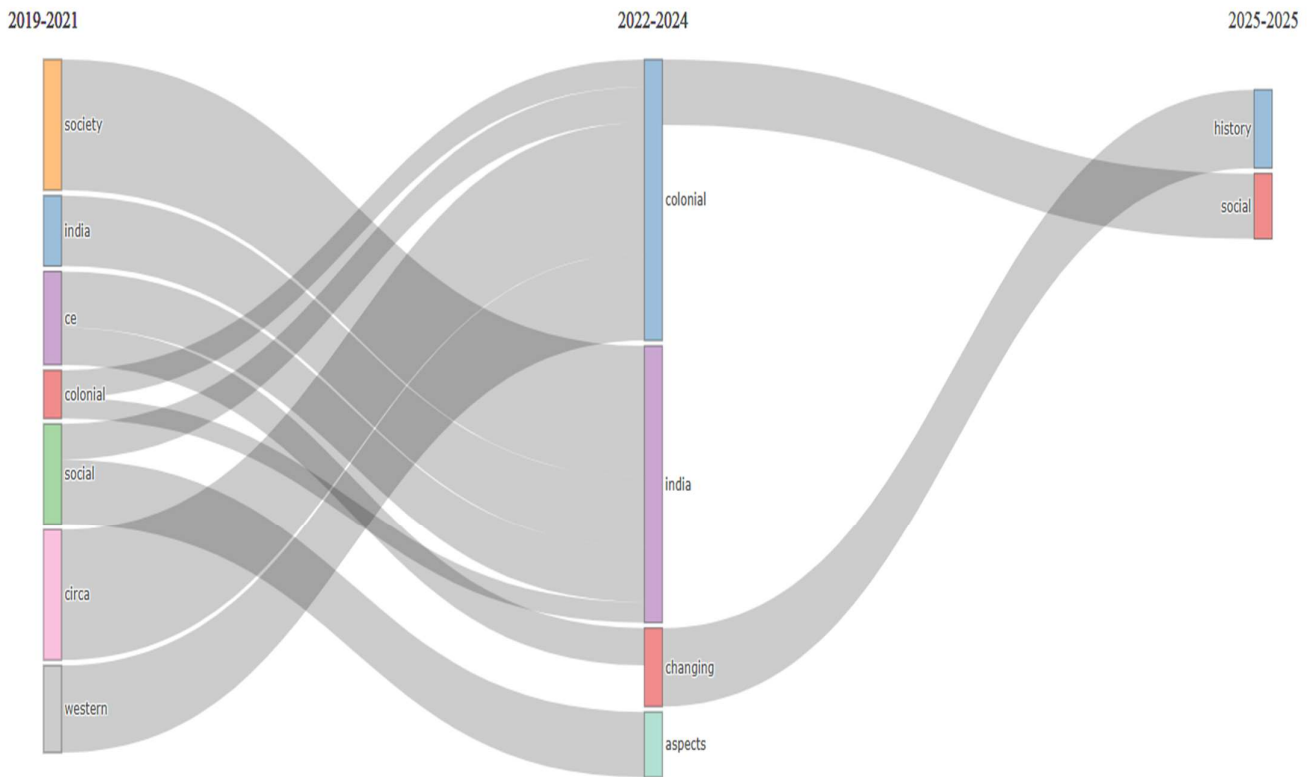


Figure 2: Thematic Evolution Map of PhD Topics from 2019 to 2025

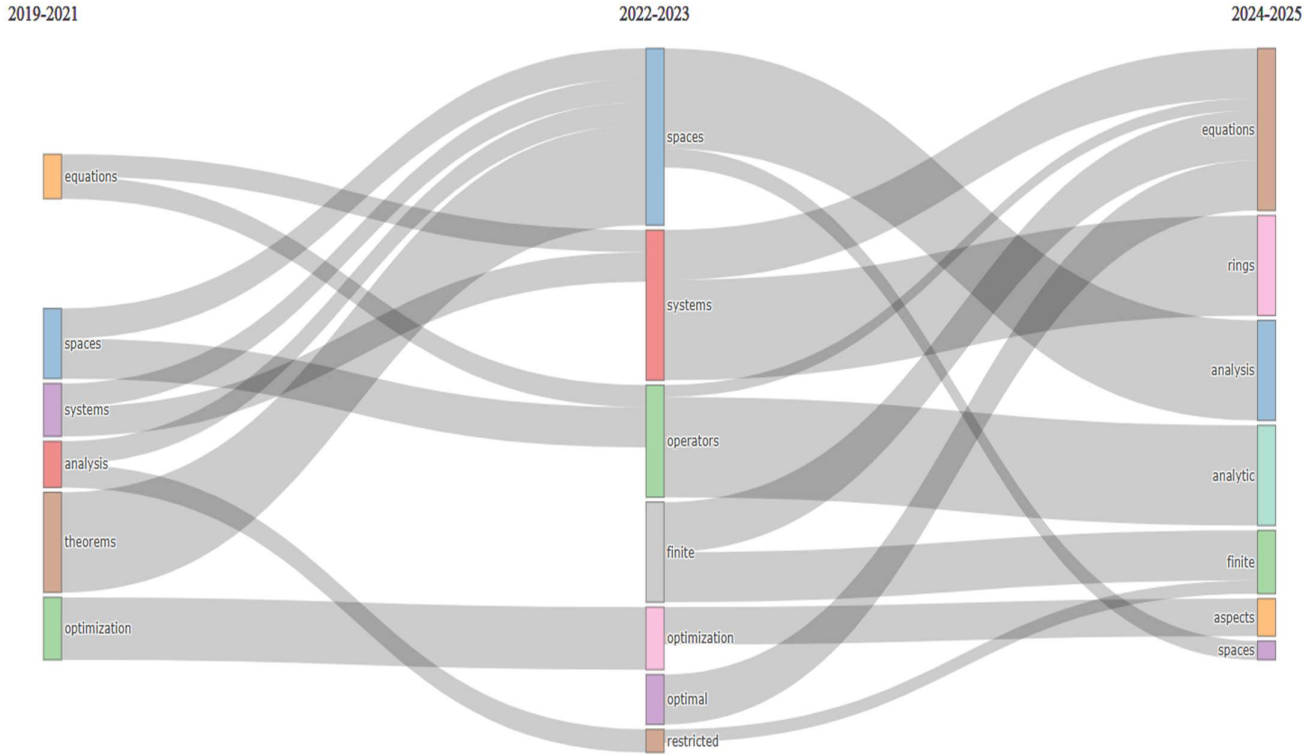


Figure 2: Thematic Evolution Map of PhD Topics from 2019 to 2025

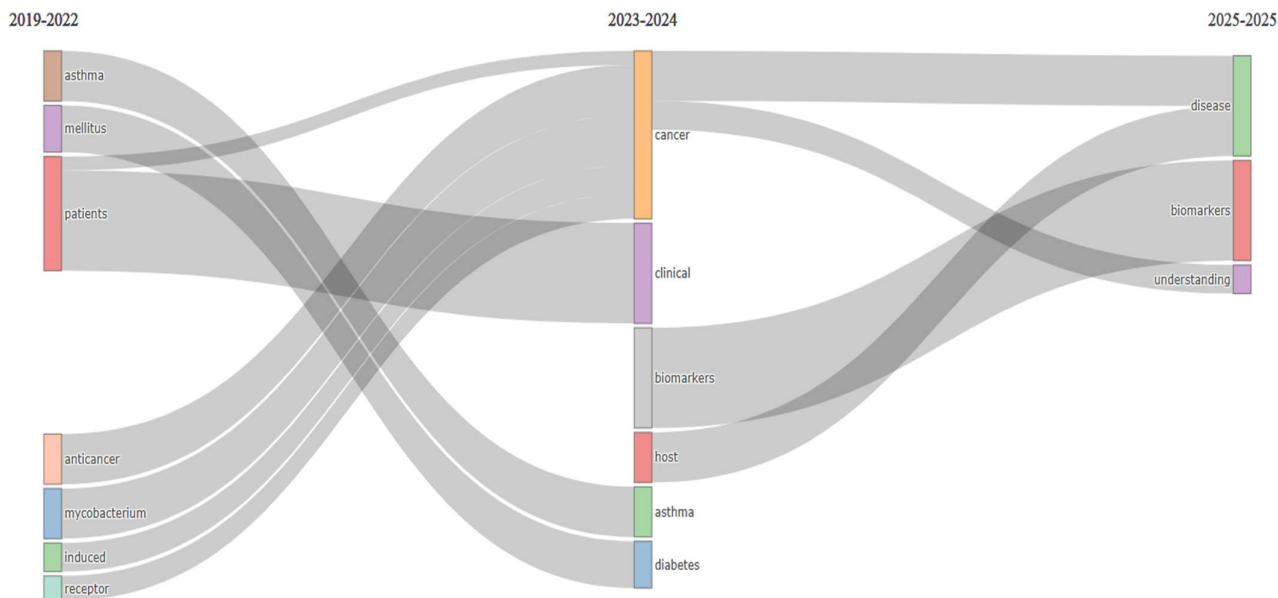


Figure 2: Thematic Evolution Map of PhD Topics from 2019 to 2025

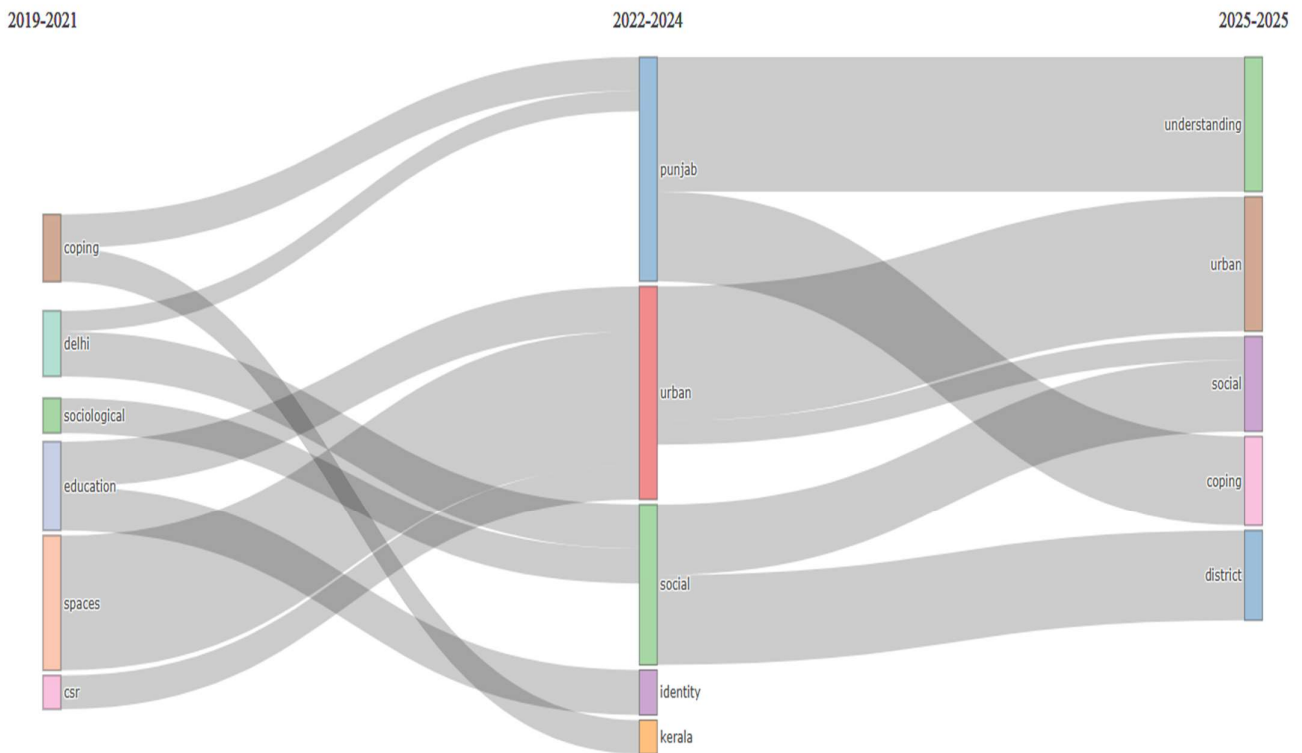


Figure 2: Thematic Evolution Map of PhD Topics from 2019 to 2025

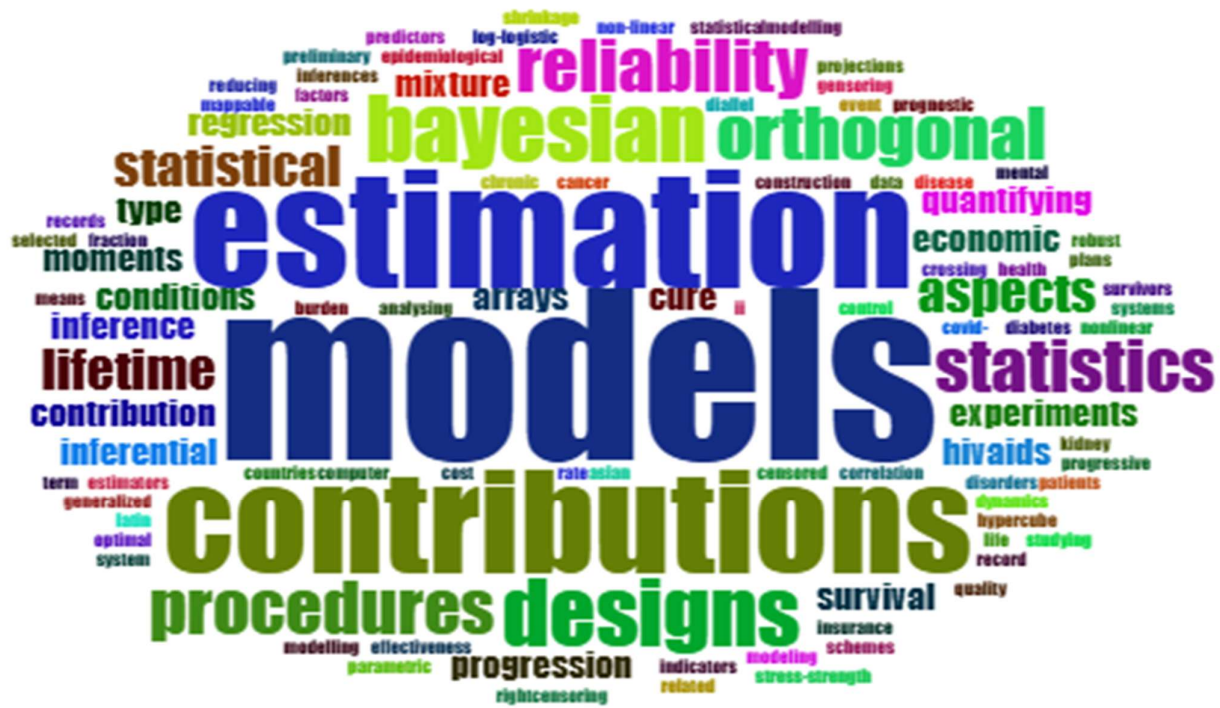


Figure 1: Word Cloud Based on Keywords extracted from the Title of the Theses

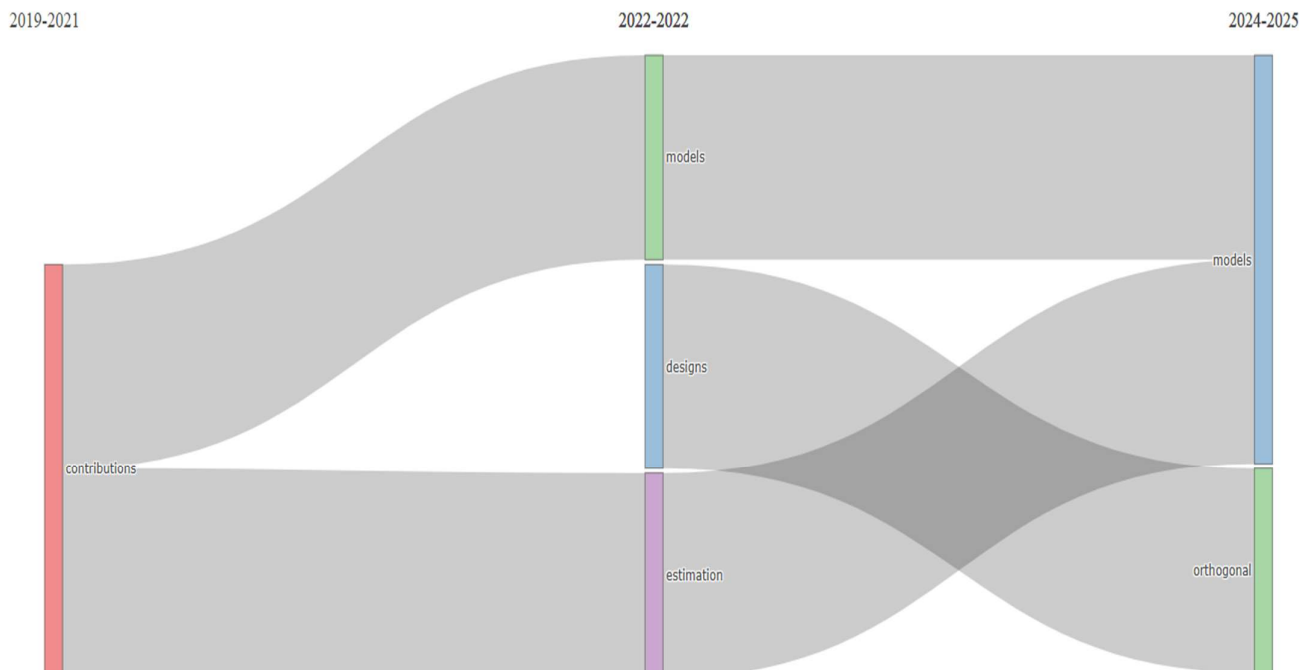


Figure 2: Thematic Evolution Map of PhD Topics from 2019 to 2025

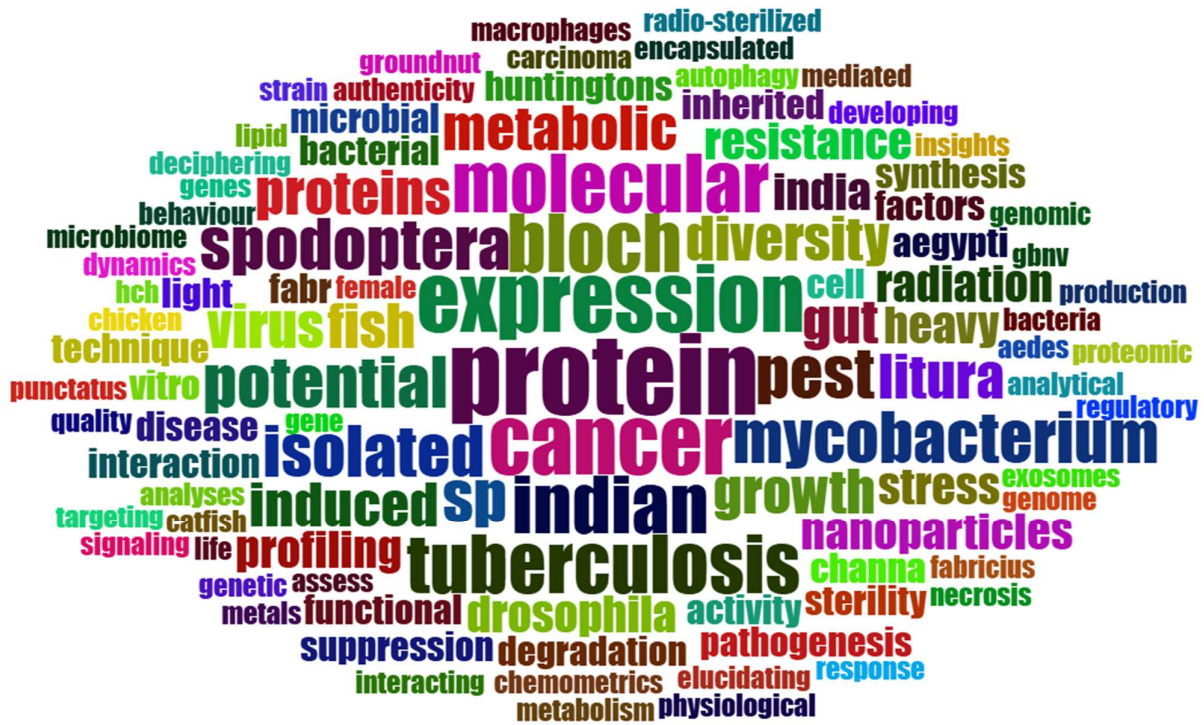


Figure 1: Word Cloud Based on Keywords extracted from the Title of the Theses

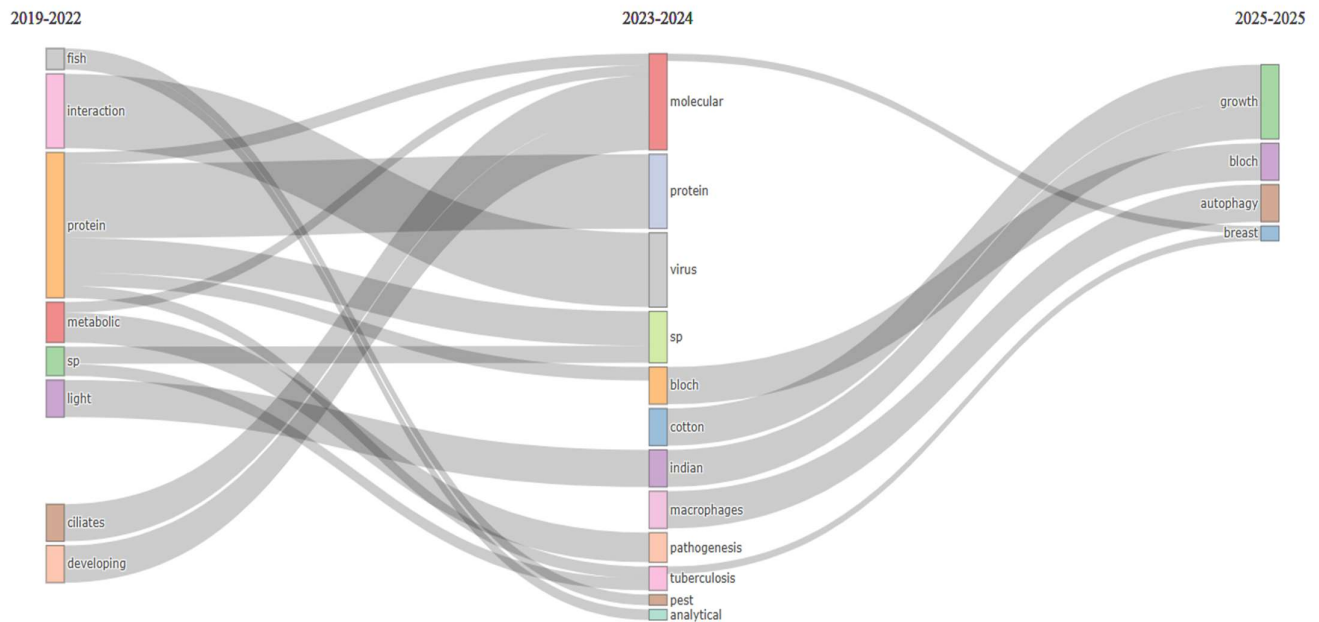


Figure 2: Thematic Evolution Map of PhD Topics from 2019 to 2025
